Tom and Katherine are an example of a family working together to achieve a better life.

Ten year old Tom experienced a great deal of instability during his early childhood. His mother died when he was six weeks old, and his father was unable to care for him. For the next five years, Tom lived with various relatives and in several foster homes until his Aunt Katherine became his permanent foster mother.

Once in school, it was determined that Tom had special needs that required mental health treatment. “Tom had issues that needed to be resolved that required more than an ordinary therapist,” Katherine recalls. “The door was slammed a lot in the beginning until my niece who had heard of Mosaic suggested we try there.”

Tom began seeing a psychiatrist and attending therapy sessions at Mosaic’s outpatient clinic. He was also referred to the off-site psychiatric rehabilitation program for community case management, which is part of Mosaic’s wraparound services for clients and families — **all part of Mosaic’s continuum of care.**

Today, Tom’s case manager regularly visits his home to help him learn the skills he needs to succeed. During weekly visits, they discuss Tom’s progress in school, how to cope with stressful situations, and how to communicate with others. In addition, Tom and Katherine attend monthly Mosaic-sponsored family dinners that are designed for education and mutual support. “The dinners are wonderful; it’s comforting to be around other families that are in the same situation,” says Katherine.

Tom is now having increased success at home and at school. Over the summer, his hard work was rewarded. “I marched in the Junior Firefighters Parade,” Tom proudly proclaims.
