JUDY'S JOURNEY HOME

"I am content and happy with my life," said Judy, with a wonderful smile.

For too long, Judy was unable to make that statement. As a young adult she would often feel 'the blues', and began experimenting with drugs as she approached middle age. Gradually, she found herself dependent and her quality of life slipping away. Judy eventually became homeless.

"I just knew there was a better life for me."

With hope and courage, Judy found a program — Mosaic — to support her desire for recovery. She was diagnosed with severe depression, and immediately began taking important steps to rebuild her life.

"I was told to come to Mosaic, and I have been here ever since. I did everything they suggested and worked the program, eventually becoming the House Manager."

Judy now has her own apartment, lives independently, and attends Coppin State University while continuing to participate in Mosaic's new integrated healthcare program. In February 2014, she celebrated six years clean!

"My nurse practitioner is so wonderful. I can call her anytime and she wants to know everything that's going on with me."

"I feel so cared for here," she says with that same sparkling smile. "I don't want to go anywhere else."

PROGRAMS & SERVICES

Mosaic offers a range of programs and services to help individuals with mental illness or addiction deal with long-term, chronic issues and crisis situations.

CLINICS

Mosaic's Behavioral Health Clinics serve adults, adolescents, and children with mental health and substance abuse assessments, individual and group therapy, and medication management.

CHILD AND ADOLESCENT SERVICES

Transitional Aged Youth (TAY) Program
Supported housing, vocational services, and service coordination for young adults ages 17-21.

Child & Adolescent In-Home Rehabilitation

In-home, wrap-around services focusing on building the behavioral skills needed to function successfully in the community.

Off-Site Counseling

Diagnostic evaluations, individual and family therapies provided in the home, school or community to children, adolescents, and their families.

Get Connected

Information, referral, and advocacy program for Carroll County families seeking services for children.

HOUSING

Residential Rehabilitation Services
Housing opportunities for clients who need varying levels of support to live successfully in the community.

Residential Crisis Program

Short-term residential program to stabilize individuals who are experiencing a mental health crisis or those who need an alternative to or step down from inpatient psychiatric hospitalization.

Transitional Aged Youth (TAY) Program

Supported housing and other services for young adults ages 17-21.

ADDICTION SERVICES

Addiction Recovery Services - Partners in Recovery

Substance abuse treatment services including suboxone maintenance, outpatient detoxification, intensive therapy and relapse prevention.

Off-Site Substance Abuse Assessment & Treatment Programs

Program providing drug screening of teen parents and adults for substance use as required by DDS and/or COA. In hospital assessments and access to treatment programs are also available.

REHABILITATION

Psychiatric Rehabilitation Day (PRP) Programs

Therapeutic day programs to help clients gain confidence to live, work and socialize successfully in the community.

Adult Medical Day Care

Specialized day programs for clients who have both mental health and primary health care needs.

VOCATIONAL SERVICES

Mosaic's vocational services provide job coaching and placement services to assist clients in securing employment.

OTHER SERVICES

Behavioral Health Home

Model of care utilizing a whole-person approach to address all of an individual's health care needs — behavioral, physical, and social.

Chesapeake Connections

Program providing intensive, wrap-around services for those with severe and persistent mental illness. Must obtain referral through Baltimore Mental Health Systems.

Mobile Treatment Services

Serves adults living in Baltimore City whose mental health treatment needs have not been met through routine, traditional outpatient mental health programs.

Off-Site Counseling

Diagnostic evaluations, individual and family therapies provided in the home, school, or community to children, adolescents, and their families.

Occupational Therapy Services

Services provided as part of enrollment in Medical Day Care of Psychiatric Rehabilitation Program (PRP).

Targeted Case Management

Serving individuals who are currently in an extended inpatient stay or have a history of multiple hospitalizations and are not linked to community support services.
