Behavioral Health Home

As an active participant in Mosaic's psychiatric rehabilitation day program, an individual may be eligible for Health Home services. The Health Home provides enhanced services and supports to individuals with serious and persistent mental illness, as well as substance use disorders/addictions.

The Health Home coordinates care and offers disease management supports through a wide range of services designed to assist individuals in addressing their primary care, social and behavioral healthcare needs, including:

- Comprehensive care management;
- Care coordination
- Health promotion
- Comprehensive transitional care
- Individual and family support services
- Referrals to community and social support services

Services are paid for through Medicaid and are at no added cost to individuals enrolled in Mosaic's psychiatric rehabilitation program.

Who We Serve

Adults with chronic mental health issues who need support in developing or maintaining the skills needed to function successfully in the community. Clients continue to receive clinical mental health services throughout their enrollment in the program.

Staffing varies by site and includes, an occupational therapist, program specialists and service coordinators.

How To Access Services or Make a Referral

The psychiatric rehabilitation programs operate Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Transportation to and from the program is available. Referrals are accepted from individuals seeking services, families, Mosaic programs, and from other mental health service providers.

What We Do

Mosaic's Psychiatric Rehabilitation Day Program (PRP) provides a wide range of support services and educational programs to promote independent living skills, such as:

- Assessment and rehabilitation planning;
- Intake and discharge planning;
- Crisis intervention;
- Service coordination;
- Medication management;
- Skill development;
- Educational opportunities;
- Vocational rehabilitation;
- Socialization
- Behavioral intervention;
- Transportation.

The program also offers therapeutic recreational components, including art; creative writing; wellness and exercise, computer classes; and group activities such as bingo. Off-site activities may include shopping trips, picnics, bowling, and visits to local attractions. Breakfast and lunch are provided.
