Jalen was a fifth grader with a stutter, a bully, and a bunch of feelings inside.

As a single mom with a grueling work schedule, Jalen's mother couldn't find a therapist whose schedule was compatible. At her wits' end, a colleague recommended Mosaic's Offsite Counseling Program.
